

**From the Vicar** – Before I was ordained the last job I did was as a volunteer coordinator for a charity. That job really affected how I think about volunteering in Church and society. I feel really strongly that volunteering can and should be vocational – something that makes life richer and fuller for the person volunteering, and the community they are serving. This doesn't mean it's glitzy and glamorous all the time – life isn't like that, nor does it need to be something that fills a while life, but it should fulfil something in the person and the community. Part of my job then and now is discerning how what that, or some of those things might be, with others. That is what is in my mind as we send out the skills audit that I spoke about in the sermon last week. There will always be things that need doing in a busy place like All Saints: things that add up to the mission of the Church. I hope that the audit will prompt you to think about what might bring something to your life, as well as help All Saints to live out our mission to all God's people – to flourish as we do.
